
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### Mounting Waterproof Cable Attachments Quick Start Anchors & Screws Top Screws Top Outlet Mounting Holes Thread the cable through the glue pad when routing the camera's cable through the top outlet. # Mount the Box

#### 1. Drill Holes


Stick the mounting template to the desired mounting place. Drill 3 screw holes and 1 cable hole (for the cable through wall/ceiling) according to the template.



### 2. Open the Box Case


Use the screwdriver to loosen the screws.

#### 3. Mount the Box Base


### Option 1: Route the cable through the wall/ceiling.



#### **How to Waterproof Cables**

When you route the cable through the wall/ceiling, you can refer to your camera's guide to waterproof the cable using the waterproof cable accessories that come with your camera.

#### For Ethernet cable:






Note:

During this process, you can also use some tape to wrap the cable and use the silicone (for outdoor use) or duct seal to weather seal the cable penetrations for better waterproofing.

#### Option 2: Route the cable through the side outlet.




#### **How to Waterproof Cables**

The junction box comes with waterproof cable attachments. You can follow the steps below to waterproof the cables.

1. Use the lid opener to remove the side waterproof plug



- 2. Route the network cable/power cable through the following components in order: fix nut, waterproof ring, waterproof jacket, and then the side outlet.
- 3. Insert and twist the waterproof jacket securely to the side outlet.
- 4. Rotate the fix nut to secure it to the waterproof jacket.



Note: During this process, you can also use some tape to wrap the cable for better waterproofing.


# **Install the Camera**

Multiple mounting holes are available for the installation of various camera types to suit different needs.

- 1. Remove the glue pad, thread the camera's cable through the upper outlet, and reapply the pad.
- 2. Connect the network cable and power cable as needed.
- 3. Select the appropriate screws and mounting holes on the junction box according to the table below.
- 4. Use screws to install the camera to the junction box by referring to the installation guide of your camera.
- 5. Secure the cover plate to the box base.

#### **Usage Tips:**

- 1. When installing the camera, some cameras (such as the VIGI C2XX series, VIGI C4XX series, and VIGI C5XX series) may block the top screws. Before installing the camera, secure the cover plate to the box base.
- 2. It's recommended to install waterproof cable attachments and route the cables into the junction box before installing the camera.


